



# Make pet dining easier with a DIY pet bowl stand.

## An easy way to boost your pet's comfort level.

Spending more time outdoors with your pet is a good thing, mealtimes included. And using an elevated bowl makes it easier all around: more comfortable swallowing and less neck and back strain for your pets, less food cleanup for you.

Rather than purchasing an elevated pet bowl stand, why not build one yourself with inexpensive, durable PVC trim boards from Royal® Building Products? It's simple.

### ALL THE MATERIALS YOU'LL NEED:

- 4 PVC boards
- Circular table saw
- Safety goggles
- 13 2" Cortex or Starborn screws and plugs
- PVC cement
- Powered screwdriver
- Dog bowls - 6" diameter
- Pencil
- Tape measure
- Non-slip shelf and drawer liner (optional)

## Step 1

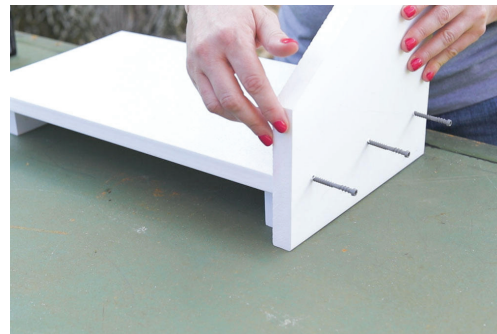
Using your tape measure, pencil and table saw, measure and cut the pieces for your stand sides, base and back to these dimensions:

- Sides (2): 10x9 ¼"
- Base: 10x16 ½"
- Back: 10x18"



## Step 2

Assemble your sides to the back of the stand using PVC cement and cortex screws.



## Step 3

Measure 2 ½" up on the sides and use PVC cement to adhere sides to the shelf. Add cortex screws to keep it in place.



## Step 4 (optional)

Measure, cut and apply your non-slip shelf liner to the base of the stand.
